## GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE CO-OP

The Central Coast Woodturners Co-op is a not for profit Co-operative and the Club was formed in 1985 by a small group of enthusiasts, to promote the art of woodturning and related skills.

We conduct monthly meetings where members and guests share information, display projects, hear guest speakers and see demonstrations.

Club details are included in the Community Directory websites of both Gosford and Wyong Shires. We have groups involved in woodturning, scroll sawing, carving, toy making and pyrography.

### MEMBERSHIP

Currently there is a \$50 joining fee which includes an annual subscription of \$40 (due on 30<sup>th</sup> June each year). Members must be at least 18 years old.

*A \$50 fee will be charged for new members wishing to learn woodturning. A \$20 fee will be charged for beginner carvers. This is to cover the cost of timber and other materials used during their training.*

### GENERAL MEETINGS

Our monthly meeting is held on the first Saturday of each month, undercover at the clubhouse at 1pm. The meetings involve sharing of relevant information, general club business and Show and Tell. The main meeting is always preceded by a sausage sizzle at about 12noon. All are welcome

### CLUBHOUSE / WORKSHOP

This is located in the old Wyong Milk Factory at 141 Alison Road, Alison (Wyong) beside M1. The workshop is well equipped and used for training and other meetings involving woodturning, scroll sawing, carving, toy making and pyrography. Training is offered to 15 year olds providing they are accompanied by a parent or other responsible adult. Merchandise is also available for purchase (members only). Opening hours are Monday and Friday ~ 8am to 3pm. Saturday 8am to noon.

### SOCIAL PROMOTIONAL EVENTS

These include liaison and visits with other clubs, demonstrations, displays, sales at shopping centres and events, such as: Australia Day celebrations, The Country Music Festival, The Orchid Festival, The Entrance Mardi Gras, and the Sydney Timber Working with Wood Show.
